All items must be clean, dry and empty. Items accepted include tin, aluminum, plas-

## Construction Materials & Tanks

Grind-able Materials: .13 per lb.

(Sheetrock, shingles, wood, plaster, tile)

Sorted Asphalt: .13 per lb.

Helium Tanks: \$2.00 each

Propane tanks:

(LP gas tanks and cylinders only; 20 lb. size limit)

**\$10.00** per 20 lb. tank \$1.00 smaller tanks;

Fluorescent bulbs \$.25 per ft.

Batteries: car/truck \$5.00; Motorcycle \$3.00 Small (power tool) \$1.00 Rechargeable \$.25 each

Motor oil is accepted free of charge

Free Hazardous Waste Days occur 3 times per year. Dates posted at transfer station.



## **Brandon Transfer Station Recycling Brochure**

All <u>pre-sorted</u> recyclables are accepted Free of Charge. All items must be clean, dry & empty.

#### Items accepted include:

#### **Glass Containers**

(Any color food & beverage containers, clear, green, brown)

MUST be clean & dry

Remove all caps and lids

Remove plastic wraps

Remove metal and plastic neck rings

Paper labels are OK

Place in designated containers

NO tramp glass (windows, mirrors, drinking glasses,

vases...)

NO china or ceramics

#### **Tin Cans**

(steel food and beverage cans, aerosol cans, cookie tins, steel screw caps and lids) WILL STICK TO

MAGNET

MUST be clean & dry
MUST remove one end
Non-aerosol cans
Remove any plastic

NO aluminum cans\*
NO partially filled cans
NO propane cylinders\*\*
NO scrap metal\*\*

Expel all gas from aerosol cans

#### **Deposit Containers** (plastic, aluminum, glass)

MUST be clean & dry
MUST have deposit label intact
Remove caps containers
Place in designated container

#### **Aluminum Foil**

(TV dinner trays, pastry trays, and foil items)

MUST be clean & dry
Remove any plastic
NO aluminum cans
NO aluminum coated plastic or paper

#### **Aluminum Cans**

(non-deposit food/beverage cans)
WILL NOT STICK TO MAGNET

MUST be clean & dry
Remove any plastic

NO li

NO aerosol cans
NO Foil Items
NO lighter refills

#### **Plastic Containers**

Sort by number on bottom

& place in appropriate bin. 1 PET – Clear Only

2 HDPE – Natural (ex: milk jugs)

2 HDPE – Colored

Remove caps, lids & sprayers; remove metal handles

& rings

Rinse and drain detergent bottles; Drain oil containers for 24 hrs.

NO plastic bags; NO tied bundles; NO plastic film;

NO caps or lids; NO sprayers or pumps; NO plastic toys or

house wares; NO roofing tar/driveway seal pails.

#### Magazines/ Newspaper Inserts

(Catalogs & similar printed materials)

MUST be clean & dry
Remove any plastic
Place in designated area

NO tied bundles
NO bags
NO books\*

#### **Newspaper**

(black and white newsprint) Remove inserts\*
MUST be clean & dry & loose
Remove colored comics\* & colored sections\*
Colored headlines & pictures in the black & white sections a re fine.

#### Office Paper

**B.** Colored Ledger

Place in designated container
Sort by type
Staples OK
NO brown envelopes
NO carbon paper
NO thermal copy fax

Remove large metal or plastic

fasteners

#### **Cardboard**

(corrugated boxes, brown paper grocery bags, brown Kraft paper)

Break down flat (open ends)
Remove string from bags

NO tied bundles
NO waxed cardboard
NO plastic-coated

#### Boxboard/Chipboard

(cereal, pasta, detergent, cake, mixes, brown envelopes, etc.)

NO beer and Soda boxes/carriers

Break down flat (open ends)

MUST be clean & dry Remove all bag liners

Remove cellophane window Remove any metal/plastic parts

Remove any foil /plastic wrap

NO tied bundles

NO pizza boxes
NO plastic coated/waxed

NO egg cartons

NO foil coated boxes

## Scrap Metal & Appliances

Scrap Metal and Appliances (ex: stove, dishwasher, washer, dryer) are accepted Free of charge.

Appliances containing Freon are charged a \$15 Freon removal fee.

All items must be empty of fluids, food and debris.

Nails and small items need to be in an enclosed/covered container.
