

Churchill Road (TH 22) 50FLAP004 – Culvert Replacement

Public Posting Document – Town of Brandon

The Town of Brandon in conjunction with the U.S. Forest Service is using Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) funds to increase public access to Forest Service Lands - Moosalamoo National Recreation Area in the Green Mountain National Forest.

The project proposes removal and replacement of a wooden bridge to be replaced with a reinforced concrete, closed box culvert 14' W X 8' D X 18' L with supporting wing walls, with related approach and channel work. The project is located on Town Highway 22 (Churchill Road) in the Town of Brandon, Vermont along an Unnamed Tributary of Leicester Hollow Brook, which joins the Neshobe River approximately 0.3 miles downstream. The work is planned for the 2019 construction season.
