2. Kirk Thomas: Parcel 0086-2580; 2598 Franklin Street; Tax Map 10-03-42.02; Commercial Bldgs & 3.58 Acres

John Peterson read the inspection report on the commercial property on 2598 Franklin Street. Mr. Thomas felt the report was an accurate depiction of the property under appeal.

3. Kirk Thomas: Parcel 0047-0003; 3 Seminary Street; Tax Map 23-50-16; Dwelling & .36 Acres

Bill Moore read the report on the property inspection report on the property on 3 Seminary Street. Mr. Thomas indicated that the report was an accurate description of the property under appeal.

4. Kirk Thomas: Parcel 0081-0877; 877 Wheeler Rd; Tax Map 07-01-50.01; Dwl & 30.85 Acres

Wendy Rowe Feldman read the inspection report on the property located on 877 Wheeler Road. Mr. Thomas concurred with the findings in the report, but wanted to note that the front of the property is a drainage area for the surrounding roads and neighbors, and it is indicated on the ANR wetlands map that he provided with his original evidence.
