The original permit was done to sell drinks in the park in a fenced-in area and at some point they decided it not to do it in the park, but out front of the business. They contacted the Liquor Commissioner who provided information on an application to complete and send in, however, the permit was done for sales through September 15th. Mr. Atherton noted the event was held two weeks ago and if the application remained in effect, they could sell through outside consumption through September 15th. The intent of the application was for an event that happened two weeks ago.

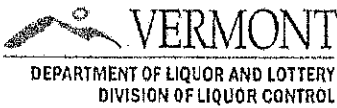
Motion by Brian Coolidge/Doug Bailey to rescind the permit #10039-001-OOCP1-003. **The motion passed unanimously.**




