Notice of Vacancy of Animal Control Officer

The Town of Brandon is seeking an individual to fulfill the role as the Animal Control Officer.

The Animal Control Officer is responsible for regulating the keeping of animals (such as dogs, cats and other domestic types) and catching such animals if they're running at large, and if they cannot be returned to their owner, to see those animals impounded for their health and safety and that of the community, and to deal with not-on-a-farm animals creating a nuisance as defined in the Town of Brandon Animal Control Ordinance.

The Animal Control Officer will report any suspected criminal activity, whether domestic or agricultural, such as neglect or abuse to the Brandon Police Department who will then proceed with investigations to determine if any charges are applicable.

The Animal Control Officer will also coordinate with the District Game Warden in dealing with any wild animal calls or complaints.

The Animal Control Officer will report directly to the Town Manager and will work with the Town Health Officer and the Brandon Police Department as needed to assist with animal issues.

This is an as needed, case by case position with a monthly stipend.
