Compile Questions for Select Board Candidates (Doug Bailey-3-yr. seat, Heather Nelson, Ralph..., others TBD) General discussion ideas: Ask about State Energy Goals? Have you read Brandon's Energy Plan – only 25 pages w/pictures? Are you aware of the Town Garage Project?, How will you as a candidate help to integrate the Energy Plan into the Town Plan?, etc. BEC set up a form with questions to distribute to potential candidates and ask for response prior to elections.
