## MINUTES OF JUNE 23, 2025

Commissioners Present: Doug Bailey, Cecil Reniche-Smith, Ralph Ethier, Brian Coolidge, Jeff Haylon

- Chair Doug Bailey called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM.

  Motion by Haylon/Reniche-Smith to adopt the agenda as posted. Voted 5-0.
- 2 Motion by Reniche-Smith/Coolidge to approve the minutes of May 26, 2025. Voted 5-0.
- Consider FY26 purchase orders
  #12446 to City of Rutland for disposal of sludge \$86,400
  #12379 to Holland Company, Inc for sodium aluminate \$43,920
  #12380 to Holland Company, Inc for sodium bisulfite \$29,555
  #12447 to Allen Engineering for sodium hypochlorite \$45,000
  #12449 to Endyne, Inc for laboratory testing \$16,664

Town manager Seth Hopkins introduced Chief Wastewater Treatment System Operator Tim Kingston and Assistant Chief Operator Ian Buckley who were available for questions. Purchase orders were completed in the manner to which the board is accustomed, with brief explanation of the process function served by the purchase and some pricing history for trend awareness. These are attractive quotes that will fit within a stable operating budget for the wastewater enterprise fund.

Motion by Coolidge/Reniche-Smith to approve all five purchase orders. Voted 5-0.

- Public comment: Brent Buehler spoke to the board highlighting their obligation as the sewer commissioners rather than as the selectboard to advocate for financial support for the sewer operations from the Shirley Farr bequest to the Town. Her bequest for sewer and sanitation could be put to good use, if not in the operating budget than for portapotties at town events such as Independence Day; Estabrook Park affairs; a revolving loan fund for Brandon residents with failing septic systems; broken sewer line repairs; etc. He stated honoring Miss Farr's wishes is the right moral, ethical, and legal thing to do. The board took these comments under advisement.
- Motion by Bailey/Haylon to approve the proposed FY26 wastewater fund budget. No increase in rates is required. Hopkins discussed this budget working more like a familiar business budget, with items like depreciation that recognize a loss in value but do not affect cash flow, and stated balancing the budget perfectly would lead to excess cash flow and higher sewer rates. The Town's practice has been to fund large sewer improvements through bonding rather than by accumulating sinking funds from the ratepayers in advance. Questions about the short-lived asset account purpose and the fund balance were answered. The FY26 wastewater budget was ready for consideration. Voted 5-0.
- 6 Motion by Coolidge/Reniche-Smith to adjourn. Not debatable. Voted 5-0.
